School shoes

In the last week we have had one or two arguments between pupils about the trainers they are wearing. Sorting out these arguments has highlighted the fact that the majority of pupils at Clifton are not wearing school shoes as part of their uniform. Instead they are wearing trainers of many types and colours!

Whilst the majority of pupils look smart in the rest of their Clifton uniform, the trainers do not look smart enough and are not appropriate for children to be wearing all day at school.

Some pupils are saying they have school shoes at home and others say they do not. May I ask you to make sure your child wears their shoes or buy them appropriate school shoes. They do not need to be expensive – for example Asda sell suitable shoes for around £15. As long as they have some grip on the soles and laces or Velcro, they will also be suitable for use on the astroturf. I have included some examples overleaf.
